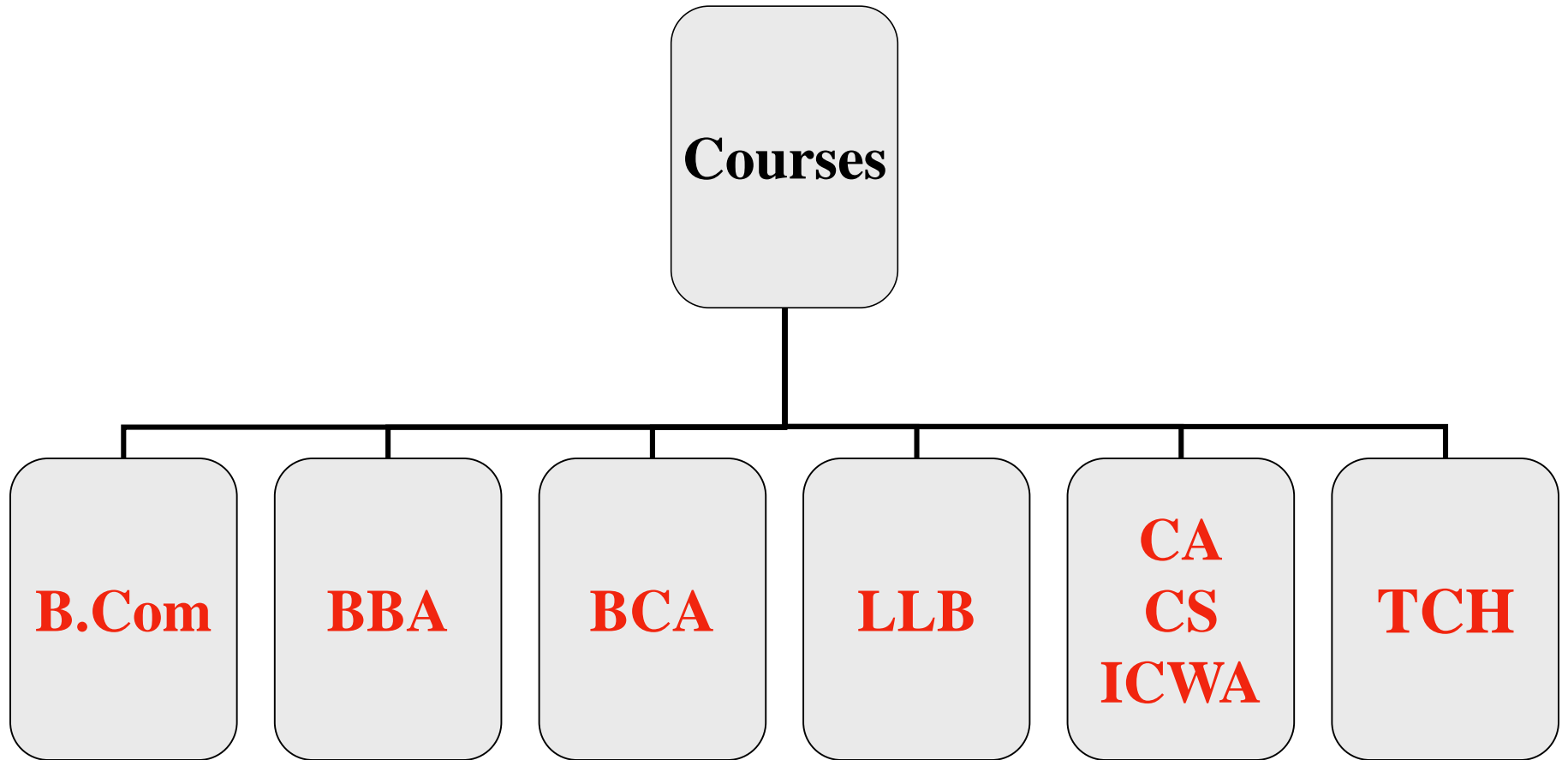

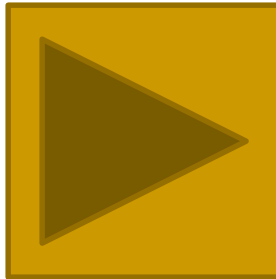

4. CA course: Key features of CA course

Common Proficiency Course (CPC)

- ▶ An entry level test for Chartered Accountancy course held twice in a year in June & December
 - ▶ CPT is a test of four subjects :
 - Fundamentals of Accounting (60 Marks)
 - Mercantile Laws (40 Marks)
 - General Economics (50 Marks)
 - Quantitative Aptitude (50 Marks)
 - ▶ The papers consist of Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ's) with negative marking of 0.25 marks for every incorrect answer
 - ▶ You need to secure a minimum of 30% marks in each subject with an overall aggregate of 100 marks out of the total 200 marks
 - ▶ Anyone who has cleared 10+2 standard examination conducted by an examination body consulted by law in India or an examination recognized by the central government may write CPT
 - ▶ Exemption for commerce graduates who have secured 55% (excluding languages) in graduation
 - ▶ Exemption for CS and CWA Intermediate passed students

Key features of CA course

Intermediate (Integrated Professional Competence) Course

- ▶ Level II of the Chartered Accountancy Course

- ▶ Held twice a year in May and November

- ▶ Course comprises of seven subjects:

- Accounting
- Law, Ethics and Communication
- Cost Accounting and Financial Management
- Taxation

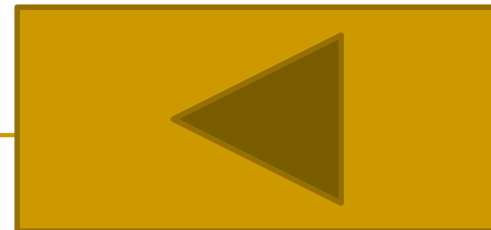


- ▶ Passing Criteria

- Appearing group-wise: 40% marks in each subject + 50% marks in the aggregate of that group

Key features of CA course

Final Course

- ▶ **Level III of the Chartered Accountancy Course**
 - ▶ **Held twice a year in May and November**
 - ▶ **Course comprises of eight subjects:**
 - **Financial Reporting**
 - **Strategic Financial Management**
 - **Advanced Auditing and Professional Ethics**
 - **Corporate and Allied Laws**

Group I

 - **Advanced Management Accounting**
 - **Information Systems and Control Audit**
 - **Direct Tax Laws**
 - **Indirect Tax Laws**

Group II
 - ▶ **Passing Criteria**
 - **Appearing group-wise: 40% marks in each subject + 50% marks in the aggregate of that group**
 - **Appearing for entire course: 40% marks in each subject + 50% marks in aggregate for all subjects taken together**

Key features of CA course

Articleship

- ▶ A CA student must obtain practical training under a CA in practice for 3 years
- ▶ During the last year, the student may opt for industrial training in any industry of his choice, in order to gain practical knowledge
- ▶ CA students get hands-on practical knowledge of the various theoretical subjects that they study
- ▶ A stipend is also paid to the students by the chartered accountants under whom they are undergoing the training, giving the students a feel of earn while you learn
- ▶ After articleship and passing of final exam, a student gets transformed into a complete professional, unlike other courses, where training commences once students pass their final examination
- ▶ Moreover, if a student undergoes articleship in a medium / large-size firm, or industrial training, the student may immediately be absorbed as an employee by the organization

Average starting salaries for fresh CAs range from 6 Lakhs to 15 Lakhs p.a

Key features of CS course

- ▶ The Company Secretaries Course (CS) is a prestigious course aimed at producing Company Secretaries who are responsible for smooth and efficient functioning of corporates
 - ▶ It is a course which transforms students into modern corporate professionals
 - ▶ The course enables you to become a high caliber professional who facilitates good corporate governance
 - ▶ In today's world, a Chartered Accountant who is also a Company Secretary has an edge over the others
 - ▶ A Company Secretary has wide opportunities professionally and is responsible for interacting, coordinating, integrating and cooperating with various other functional heads in a company
 - ▶ You could also set up your own practice or alternatively seek employment in the corporate world
 - ▶ Many subjects in CS overlap with CA thereby reducing efforts and strain to clear the course
 - ▶ The exams are held twice a year, in June and December
 - ▶ The CS course is comprised of 3 levels- CS Foundation, CS Executive and CS Professional

Key features

- ▶ Eligibility – 10+2 . Exam 8 months after registration
- ▶ MCQ-based examination of 200 marks
- ▶ Minimum 50% to be obtained; no negative marking
- ▶ Level is exempt to CPT-passed students and Final pass of ICoAI

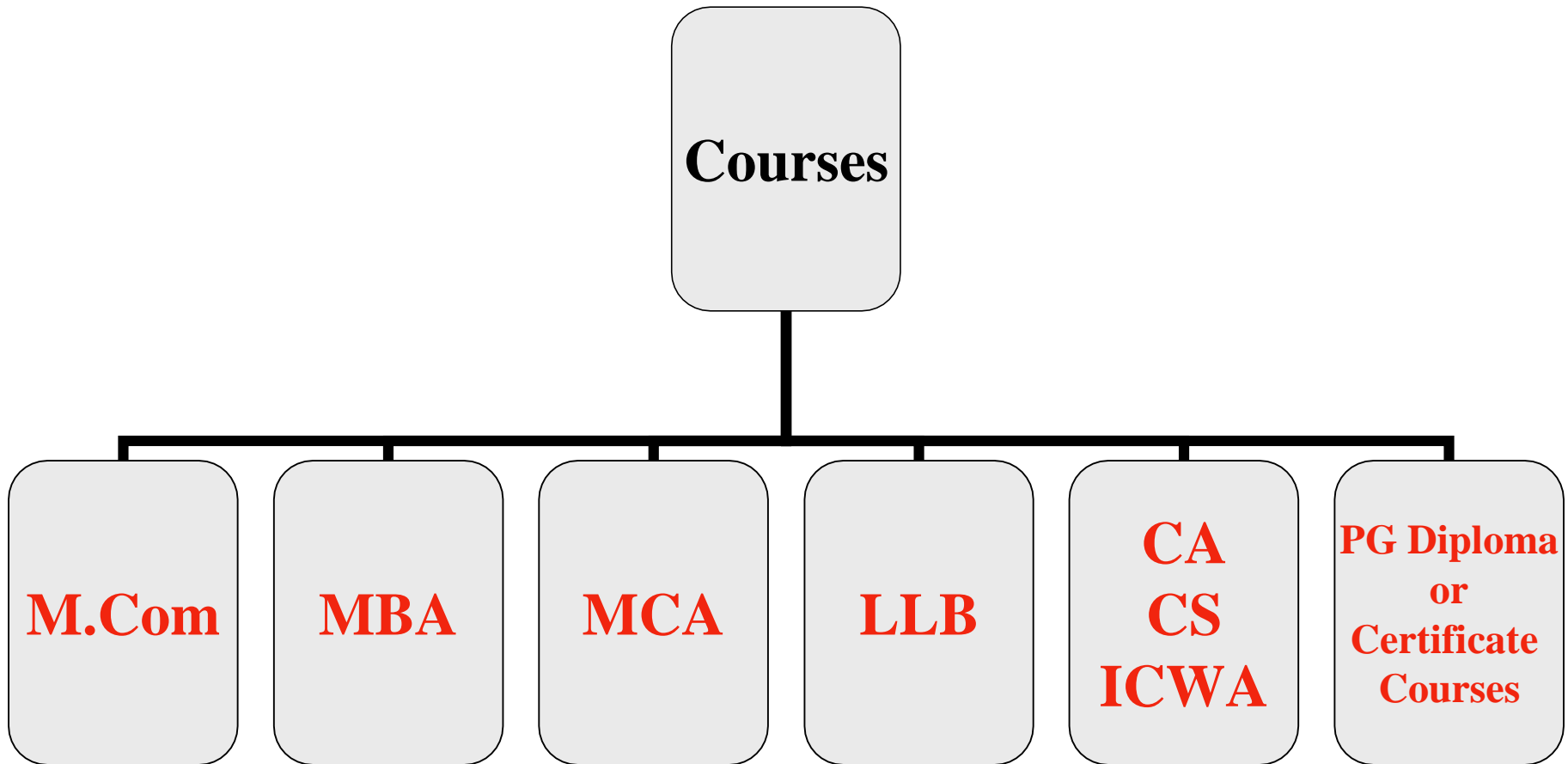
Practical Training

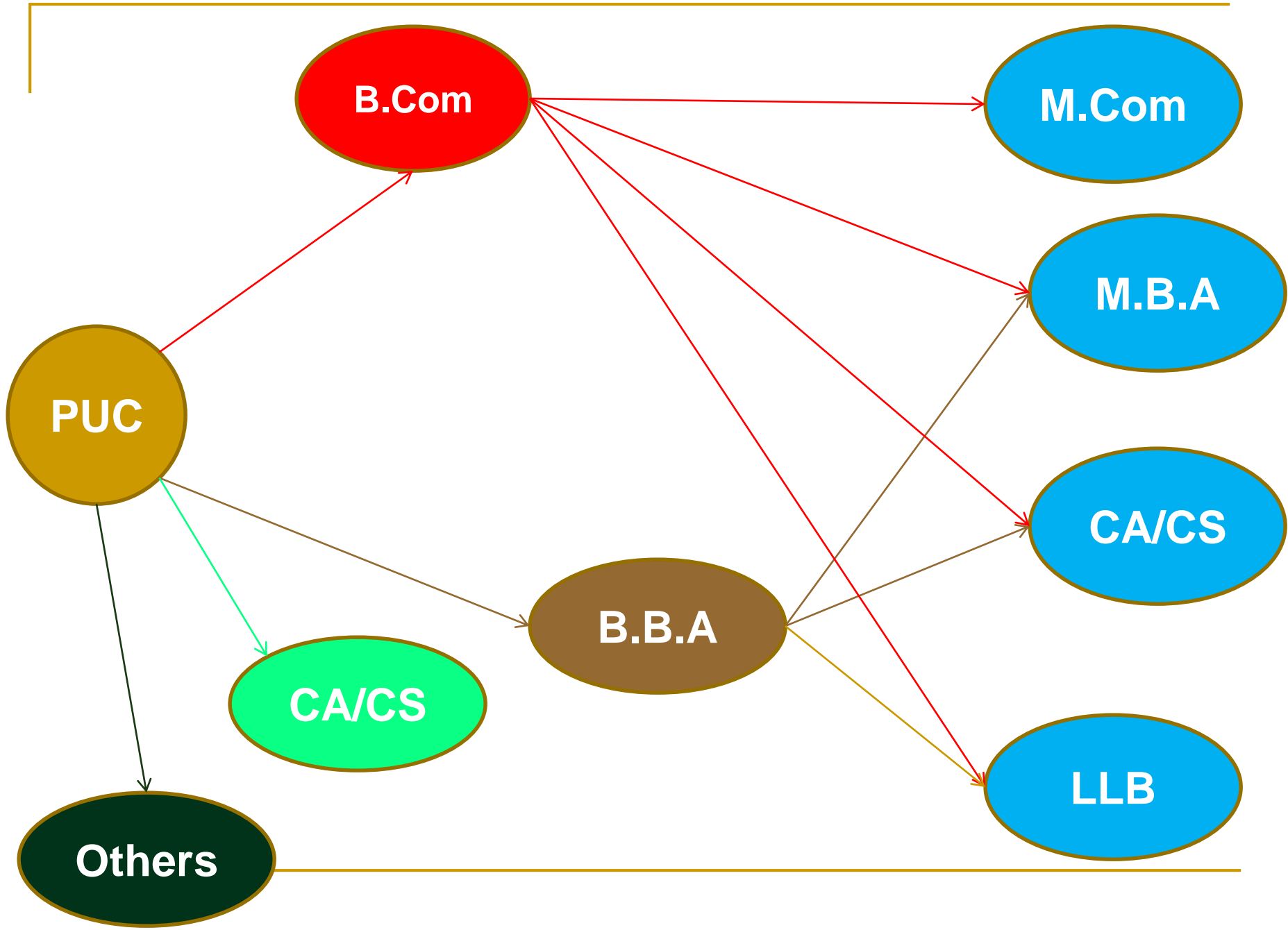
- ▶ **After clearing CS Professional, you would need to work for 15 months under a practicing Company Secretary / a company approved by ICSI to conduct the training for the students**
- ▶ **Apart from the above, you would also need to undergo a compulsory practical training of 4 months (includes Management Skills Training Programme) to be a certified Company Secretary**

Reciprocal Exemptions are available to students having passed Final Examination of ICoAI

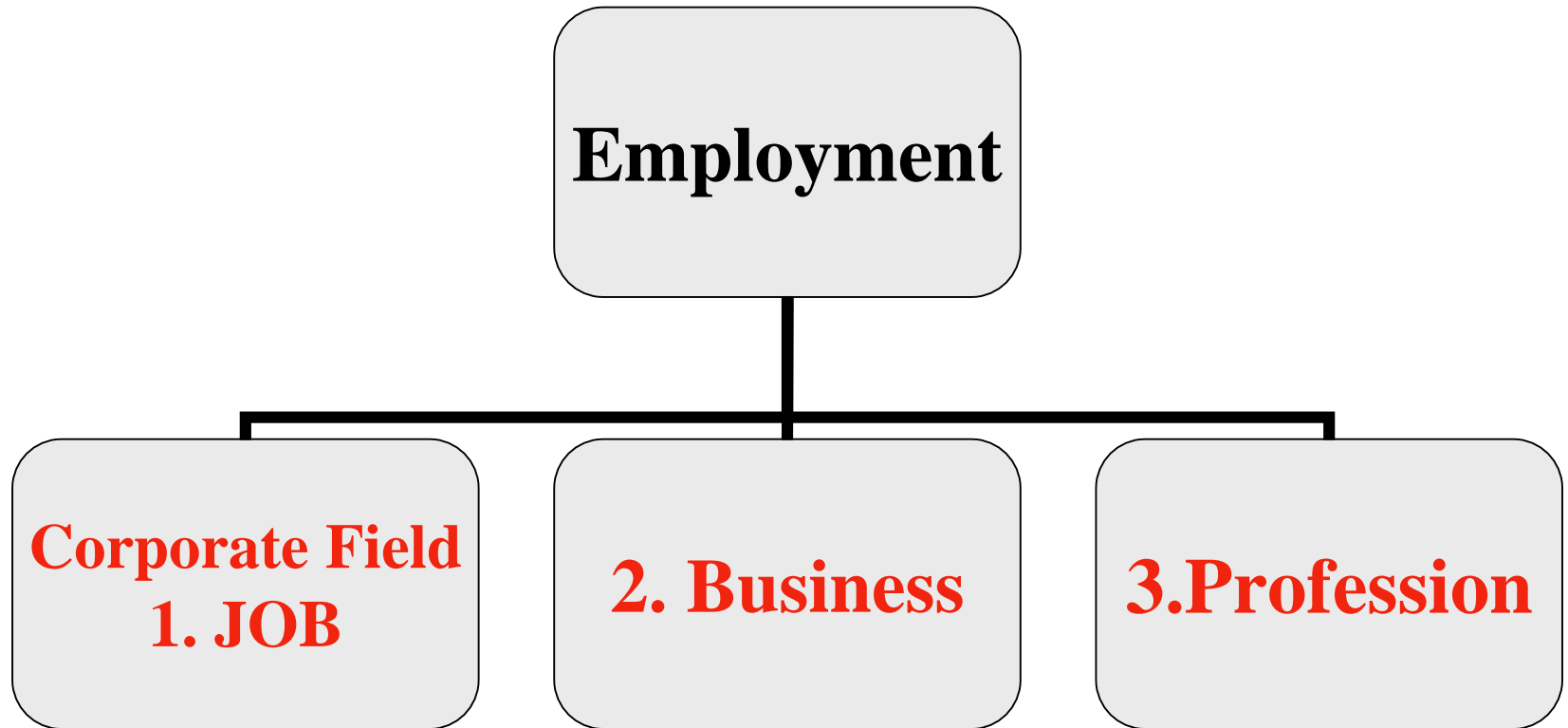

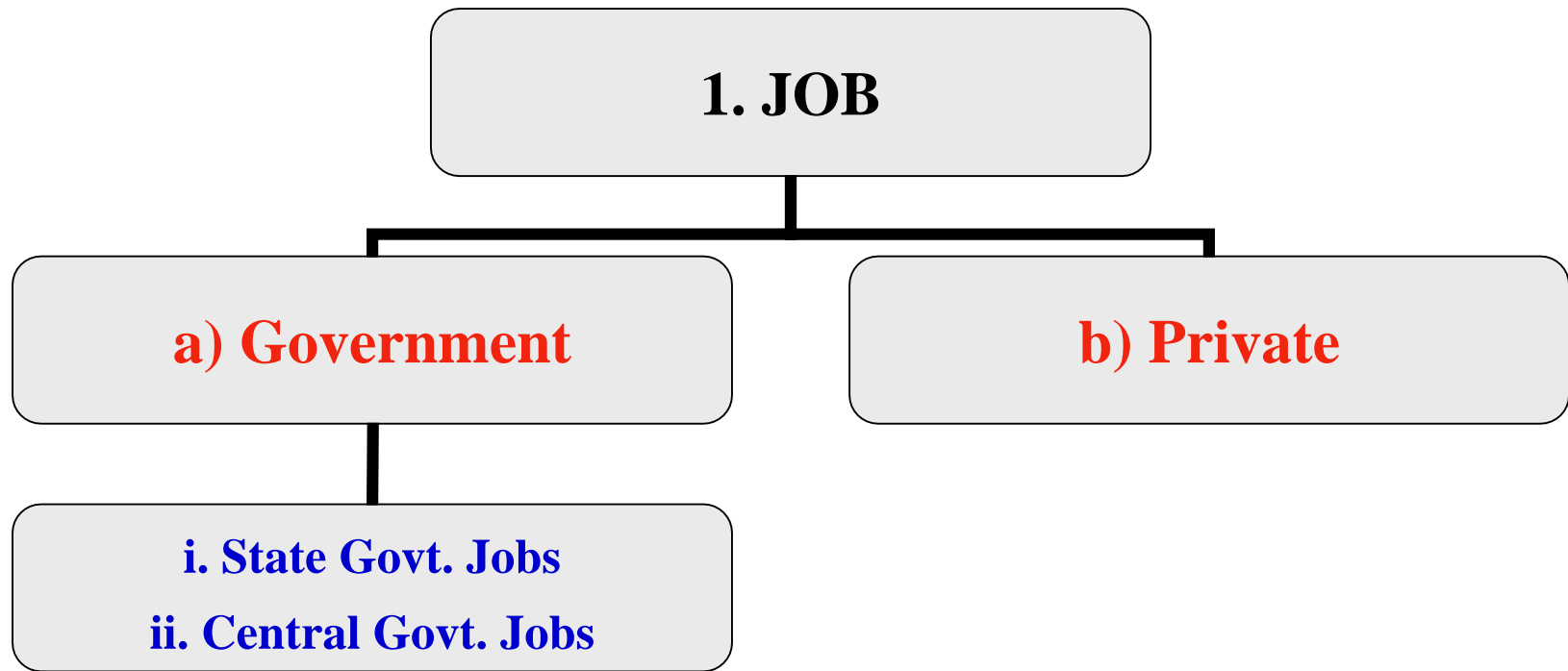
